



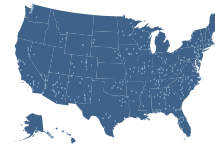

IT COSTS AN AVERAGE OF **\$3 MILLION ANNUALLY** TO OPERATE ONE AIR MEDICAL BASE

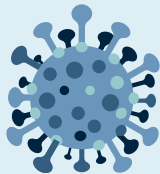

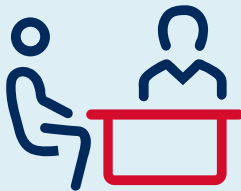
